Appendix 1. Regulations on the Zemstvo Post of Slobodskoy Uyezd since 1880

Journals of the Slobodskoy Uyezd Zemstvo Assembly, XXIII Regular Session of 1879. Vyatka. Kuklin Printing House, 1880. *Approved on October 8, 1879, at the XIII Regular Session of the Slobodskoy Uyezd Zemstvo Assembly.*

1. The Zemstvo Post is established by the Uyezd Zemstvo for the free delivery of: a) government packets; b) private letters—both ordinary and registered; c) postal announcements; d) periodicals and newspapers; and e) parcels, both government and private, weighing no more than 10 lbs.
 - *) **Note:** Bulky parcels, items containing fragile goods, liquids, or items otherwise inconvenient for transport shall not be accepted.
2. Addresses must be written clearly and specifically; parcels must be securely packed and tied crosswise with twine.
3. Out-of-town correspondence must be paid for according to the state postal tariff; when delivering parcels and registered letters to the State Post, postmen shall, upon their return trip, deliver the receipts from the state post office to the original points of dispatch.
4. Correspondence is accepted: a) at the Zemstvo Board every day, except Sundays and holidays, from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM; and b) at volost (township) administrations, also daily. However, on post-departure day (Friday), it is accepted only from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM. Correspondence accepted after this time will remain at the Board until the next post.
5. Each postman (for each route) is issued two logbooks: in one, the Route Book, he records correspondence going into the district from the city of Slobodskoy and from the state post; in the other, the City Book, he records items going from the district to the Board, the city, and the state post.
6. Volost administrations shall enter received correspondence into their own delivery books, which the postman must sign upon receiving the mail.
7. The Zemstvo Post departs from the city of Slobodskoy on Fridays according to a single schedule and travels along three routes: Vyatka-Perm, Kaysky, and Noshulsky.
8. On the Vyatka-Perm route, the postman travels to the Sezenevskoye volost administration, detours to the Kosinskoye, Mukhinskoye, and Sunskoye administrations, returns to Kosinskoye, then back to the main route to the Ostrovnovskoye administration, and returns from there to the city.
9. On the Kaysky route, two postmen operate: one (the City postman) travels to Voroninskaya station, hands over the mail to the Kaysky postman, and returns to the city; the other (the Kaysky postman), carrying mail from Kay and intermediate volost administrations, arrives at the station, receives the mail from the City postman, hands over his own, and returns to Kay.
10. On the Noshulsky route, the postman travels to the village of Polomskoye (Spasskoye), from which he returns to Slobodskoy, stopping both ways at the Retkinskoye volost administration to exchange correspondence for the Sochnevskaya and Marakulinskaya volosts. This exchange is conducted via coachmen (*yamshchiks*) sent by the Sochnevskoye and Marakulinskaya administrations.
11. The remaining volost administrations—Stulovskoye, Shepelevskoye, and Zherebtsovskoye—being located away from the postal routes, shall send their own

messengers on Saturdays to deliver their correspondence to the Board and collect mail destined for their volosts.

12. Both incoming and outgoing correspondence is recorded in a booklet brought by the messenger, and a separate logbook is maintained for this at the Board.
13. Stopping points for postmen are designated at volost administrations, which serve as sites for the receipt and delivery of both government and private correspondence; from there, mail is distributed throughout the volost. If there is no volost administration, postmen will deliver and collect mail directly from government or Zemstvo officials.
14. Upon returning to the city, postmen shall deliver city-bound correspondence to the specified addresses on the same or following day; district-bound mail is sorted by route.
15. Individuals wishing to collect their mail directly from the Board may do so provided they are known to the Board or present proof of identity.
16. Responsibility for improper delivery, the integrity of correspondence, and general failure to fulfill postal duties rests with the postmen and the Head of the Zemstvo Post, as well as with the volost administrations within the scope of their respective duties.

Appendix 2. Regulations on the Zemstvo Post of Slobodskoy Uyezd since 1889

Regulations on the Zemstvo Post of Slobodskoy Uyezd. Vyatka. Provincial Printing House. 1889. *The previous regulations of 1879 were supplemented at the XXI (Oct 4, 1887), XXII (Oct 2 and Oct 7, 1888), and XXIII (Sep 10 and Oct 3, 1889) sessions of the Slobodskoy Uyezd Zemstvo Assembly.*

1. The Zemstvo Post is established by the Uyezd Zemstvo for the free delivery of: a) government packets; b) private letters—ordinary and registered; c) postal announcements; d) periodicals and newspapers; e) parcels (government and private) weighing no more than 10 lbs. and valued at no more than 10 rubles each; and f) money correspondence up to 50 rubles per individual. The acceptance of money correspondence is established in all volosts (townships) of the district where there is a Zemstvo postal connection.
 - *) Note: Bulky parcels, items containing fragile goods, liquids, or items otherwise inconvenient for transport shall not be accepted.
2. Anyone wishing to send the aforementioned correspondence from the city shall deliver it to the Zemstvo Board; in the district, to the volost administration closest to their place of residence.
3. Receipts from a logbook are issued upon the acceptance of money letters; for government packets, signatures are made in delivery books.
4. Addresses must be written clearly; parcels must be securely packed and tied crosswise with twine. Money letters are accepted unsealed and are forwarded from the Uyezd Board to volost administrations in a special packet addressed to the administration and sealed with the Board's seal; from the administration to the Board, they are sent similarly with a registry list.
5. Out-of-town correspondence must be paid for according to the state postal tariff at the time of submission. Each volost administration shall be provided with the official tariff. For registered letters submitted to the State Post, postmen shall provide the state post office receipts during their return trip. For money correspondence, a receipt is issued by the Board or volost administration at the point of origin.
6. Correspondence is accepted: a) at the Zemstvo Board daily (except Sundays and holidays) from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM; on Fridays and Tuesdays only from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM; for the Noshulsky route, only from 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM. Items submitted

- later will wait until the next post. b) At volost administrations daily, except for the Twelve Great Feasts. The same procedure applies to money and parcel correspondence for the Glazov route (likely a correction for the text's mention of "Glazov Uyezd").
7. Each postman is issued two logbooks per route: a Route Book for mail going to the district and a City Book for mail going to the city/state post. For parcels and money, two additional books (in duplicate) are provided: one for items from the city to the district, the other for items from the district to the city. One copy stays with the postman, the other is submitted to the Board for audit.
 8. A special book is used for recording and handing over parcel/money correspondence to postmen; senders receive receipts from this book, and postmen sign for the money in it.
 9. Volost administrations record incoming mail in delivery books where the recipient signs. For money and parcels, they maintain two books (in duplicate): one for incoming items (issuing receipts to postmen) and one for outgoing items (receiving receipts from postmen and issuing them to senders).
 10. Collection of parcels and money from the State Post is performed based on special powers of attorney from the addressees to the Board.
 11. Money parcels and letters must be marked with a reference number from the logbook and the amount of postal fees collected.
 12. Correspondence in volost administrations is handled by a member of the administration or the volost clerk. In case of loss of money or fees, the members of the administration bear financial liability to the Zemstvo.
 13. Every parcel and money shipment is guaranteed by Zemstvo funds. However, the Zemstvo provides no compensation for sums not properly paid for with the postal fee; in such cases, it only takes measures to identify the guilty parties.
 14. All accepted items are recorded, and incoming mail must be delivered to addressees without delay, strictly requiring a signature upon receipt.
 15. Books for money correspondence are audited on-site by Board members every two months, with audit results certified in the books (date and signature).
 16. The cost of books for volost administrations and scales for weighing mail is covered by the Zemstvo.
 17. The Zemstvo Post departs twice a week (Fridays and Tuesdays) and follows three routes: Glazovsky, Noshulsky, and Kaysky.
 18. On the Vyatka-Perm route, the postman travels to Sezenevskoye, detours to Kosinskoye, Mukhinskoye, and Sunskoye, returns to Kosinskoye, continues to Ostrovnovskoye, and returns to the city.
 19. On the Noshulsky route, the post departs Friday at 12:00 PM via Stulovo, Shepelevo, Sovye, Ankushino, Lekma, Shestakovo, Vagino, Retkino, Nagorskoye, Polomskoye, the stations of Dubrovskaya and Babkinskaya, through Rakalovskoye and Fedoseyevskoye administrations to the Glavno-Kholunitsky Works and Ilyinskoye administration, then returns to Slobodskoy. On the Kaysky route, the city postman travels on Tuesday via Ilyinskoye and all Noshulsky route points but returns to the city directly from Shestakovo.
 20. Marakulinskaya administration sends messengers with mail to Sochnevskoye twice a week (Saturdays and Wednesdays) to exchange mail with the postmen.
 21. The Kaysky postman travels from Kay and the Kirshinsky Works to Dubrovskaya station twice a week (Friday and Tuesday) to exchange mail with city postmen. In spring and autumn (Apr 1 – May 15; Sep 15 – Nov 15), the Kaysky postman travels only once a week (Tuesdays), and the city postman does not visit Dubrovskaya station during these periods.
 22. Mail between Glavno-Kholunitsky and Chernokholunitsky Works is delivered by Zemstvo coachmen (*yamshchiks*).

23. Stopping points are at volost administrations; where none exist, postmen deliver to/receive from government/Zemstvo institutions or officials directly.
24. Upon return to the city, postmen deliver city-bound mail to addresses the same or following day and sort district-bound mail by route.
25. Individuals may collect mail directly from the Board if they are known or present identification.

Appendix 3. Regulations on the Zemstvo Post of Slobodskoy Uyezd. Vyatka. 1903.

Regulations on the Zemstvo Post of Slobodskoy Uyezd. Vyatka. Provincial Printing House. 1903. *The previous regulations were supplemented at various sessions of the Slobodskoy Uyezd Zemstvo Assembly.*

1. The Zemstvo Post is established by the Uyezd Zemstvo for the free delivery of: a) government packets; b) private letters (ordinary and registered); c) postal announcements; d) periodicals and newspapers; e) parcels (government and private) weighing no more than 10 lbs. and valued at no more than 10 rubles; and f) money correspondence up to 100 rubles per individual. Money correspondence is accepted in all volosts (townships) with Zemstvo postal service.
 - **Note 1:** Bulky, fragile, liquid, or otherwise inconvenient parcels are not accepted.
 - **Note 2:** Parcels over 10 lbs. but under 1 pood (approx. 36 lbs.) are accepted only from Zemstvo employees and institutions entitled to free state mail. In case of a backlog, the Board may defer heavy parcels to the next scheduled post. Private individuals and institutions (e.g., the church candle warehouse) are not entitled to free delivery of parcels over 10 lbs.
2. Mail is submitted to the Zemstvo Board in the city or to the nearest volost administration in the district.
3. Receipts are issued for money letters; government packets are signed for in various logbooks.
4. Addresses must be clear; parcels must be securely tied. Money letters are accepted unsealed and forwarded in special sealed packets between the Board and administrations.
5. Out-of-town mail must be paid according to the state tariff upon submission. Postmen return state post receipts to the senders. A rigorous system of duplicate logbooks (Board vs. State Post) is maintained for registered mail. In case of a lost registered letter, the Zemstvo is liable for 10 rubles, provided the loss is reported within state-defined timeframes.
6. Hours of acceptance: Money correspondence is accepted at the Board daily from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM; on post-departure days (Tuesday and Friday), only until 12:00 PM. At volost administrations, daily except for the Twelve Great Feasts. Government and parcel mail is accepted until 1:00 PM on departure days.
7. Postmen carry two books per route (Route and City). Money and parcels require duplicate books—one for the postman and one for Board audits.
8. The Board issues a special book for parcel/money mail; senders receive receipts, and postmen sign for the funds.
9. Volost administrations record incoming mail in delivery books. They also maintain duplicate books for money/parcels (incoming and outgoing).
10. Chain of Custody: Money letters must be logged by the Head of Post (in the city) or authorized volost officials. Postmen must sign for each individual letter. Exchanges between city and Kaysky postmen require mutual signatures in each other's books.

11. Collection of registered/money mail from the State Post requires a special power of attorney from the addressee.
12. All money items must be marked with their logbook number and the amount of fees collected.
13. Volost officials or clerks (authorized by the board) handle mail. Members of the volost administration bear financial liability for lost money or fees.
14. The Zemstvo guarantees money and valued parcels. No compensation is paid for unvalued or unpaid items. Claims for loss must be filed within two years of submission; after this period, the Zemstvo bears no responsibility.
15. All items must be logged; delivery to addressees must be immediate and requires a signature.
16. Money logbooks are audited by Board members on-site every two months.
17. The Zemstvo covers the cost of logbooks and postal scales.
18. Post departs twice a week (Friday and Tuesday) along three routes: Glazovsky, Noshulsky, and Kaysky.
19. Glazovsky Route: On Tuesdays, the postman goes to Ostrovnovskoye, then to Kosinskoye, Mukhinskoye, and Sunskoye, returning via "Zuevka" railway station to Sezenevskoye and then to the city. On Fridays, the route starts with Sezenevskoye and follows a similar circuit. Mail for these volosts is handed over at the Sezenevskoye post office (or the administration if the office is closed).
20. Noshulsky Route: Departs Friday at 3:00 PM via Stulovo, Shepelevo, Sovye, etc., to Glavno-Kholunitsky and Ilyinskoye. Kaysky Route: Departs Tuesday at 3:00 PM. Mail for Klimkovsky and Chernokholunitsky is handed to the "factory post" at Glavno-Kholunitsky. *Note: Between Nagorskoye and Mulinskoye, mail is carried by boat in spring.*
21. Local Connections: Mail between Kaygorodskoye and Gidayevskoye is carried by coachmen (*yamshchiks*) on Mondays. Similar arrangements exist between Marakulinskoye and Sinegorskoye via Lipovskaya station.
22. Kaysky postmen meet city postmen at Babkinskaya station via Ivantsovskoye twice a week. In spring/autumn, this frequency is reduced to once a week. Some volosts (e.g., Lekma) receive mail via messengers from Shestakovo during "muddy" seasons.
23. Mail to Chernokholunitsky is delivered via the factory postal service.
24. Stopping points are at volost administrations. Where none exist, postmen deal with officials directly. *Note: Deans (Blagochinnye) and clergy in Volosnitskoye receive mail directly from postmen; other clergy use the standard volost system.*
25. City delivery occurs on the day of return or the following day.
26. Direct pickup from the Board is allowed with proof of identity.
